If your child is in 1st-6th grade you may complete the following information giving them permission to leave their program without being escorted by you.

Check-In & Check-Out

Early Childhood Children (from birth to kindergarten) must be signed in and out by a parent or authorized caregiver. When they sign in they will be given a number that must be returned in order to pick up their child.

Elementary Children (from 1st-6th grade) must be picked up by a parent or an authorized caregiver unless a one-time waiver form is signed (located to the right).

Teens do not require an escort for dismissal from age-level programming.



While we welcome all children and youth, the one time we would rather they stay home is when they are not feeling well. If the following symptoms are present, we ask that your child not participate in age-level programming for the health of other children and volunteers:

- Fever over 99 oral (not including fever associated with teething)
- · Vomiting in the last 12 hours
- Diarrhea in the last 12 hours (in case of flu symptoms)
- Skin rashes or eruptions of unknown origin (impetigo, measles, chicken pox, etc.)

*If your child contracts any of these or another contagious illness, please notify the church office at 816-763-6891. The church office will pass information along to others who may have been exposed.


- Persistent coughing associated with respiratory infection, including cold, bronchitis, and pneumonia.
- Pink eye that may have a colored discharge or drainage.
- Parasites, any form of lice, mites, or ringworm.
